Grape variety: Sauvignon

Soils: The sandy-silt soil enhances the aromatic expression of the Sauvignon Blanc grapes.

Vinification: Direct pressing et cold stabulation

Tasting notes: Pale and bright color. Intense nose with notes of citrus. On the palate, this wine is well-balanced with a lovely freshness Intense and complex aftertaste with a hint of sweetness.

Wine pairing: Seafood, grilled fish, poultry...
