**Grape variety:** Merlot

**Soils:** Combination of clay/gravel and sandy

**Vinification & ageing:** The short maceration enhances the pleasure and aroma of red fruit

**Tasting notes:** Beautifully ruby dense and bright colour wine with purple highlights. The nose is intense and complex. A fruity wine with notes of black cherry, blackcurrant, and blackberry.

This unctuous wine has a concentrated attack enhanced with a fresh bouquet of red fruits and displays a nice long finish.

**Wine pairing :** vegetables tagliatelles, quinoa salad, strawberry salad

**Bottle size :** 75 cl
