Grape variety: 100% Merlot

Soils: Clay-limestone

Vinification and maturation: Aged for 12 months in

barrels.







Tasting notes: This wine has a beautiful, deep and intense black colour. intense colour. The nose delivers aromas of red fruits and black cherry. This wine is perfectly balanced between woody notes and red fruit aromas. The tannins are supple but well present, which gives a nice structure associated with a superb length in the mouth.

Food pairings: Sliced duck, roast poultry, gratins, cheese platter.

Capacity: 75 cl

A wine made in association with the winemaker Matthieu Cosse and the winegrowers Murielle and Bernard Marchand.
