THIS FRENCH SAUVIGNON BLANC HAS A SHINY YELLOW PALE COLOR. THE NOSE IS EXPRESSIVE WITH CITRUS FRUIT NOTES. THE PALATE IS LIVELY AND BRIGHT WITH SOME SWEETNESS AND GOOD ACIDITY. VERY AROMATIC FINISH.

History :

Do you know why our wine is called Lion and the Lily? On the coat of arms of Bordeaux, you'll find a lion and three lilies. The lilies are the historic symbol of French kings, and the lion (which originally used to be 3 leopards), was the symbol of Richard I of England (aka Lionheart). This name is a subtle yet modern nod to the history of our beautiful city of Bordeaux where our wine comes from.
