



GRAPE VARIETY: Merlot

SOILS: The grape stem from different terroirs, whose soils range from sandy and gravely to clay-limestone.

VINIFICATION: Direct pressing, temperature control.

TASTING NOTES: The robe is light pink and vibrant.

Very aromatic on the nose with notes of red fruits.

On the palate, the wine is well-balanced and fruity with aromas of blackcurrant, strawberry, enhanced by a nice sweetness. Long finish.

WHAT IS A CARRELET?

It's a fisherman's hut with a unique architectural silhouette found on the banks of French estuaries, most notably in the Gironde region.
